**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On July 8, 2025, the Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of the matter, because the Secretary is prohibited from garnishing wages of a debtor who has been involuntarily separated from employment until the debtor has been continuously reemployed for at least 12 months. See 31 C.F.R. § 285.11(j). As such, the Secretary will not seek collection of the debt at this time, but reserves the right to resume collection activities when Petitioner becomes eligible.

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
