The Arizona Department of Health Services (DHS) certifies compliance with the provisions of the Keys Amendment (section 1616(e) of the Social Security Act; 45 CFR Part 1937).

DHS is the agency in the State of Arizona legislatively mandated to establish, maintain, and enforce standards for health care institutions, including Nursing Care, Medical and Assisted Living facilities. We have adopted Arizona Administrative Code rules for the licensure of health care institution and copies of our rules are available to the public.
