As Commissioner of the Department of Health and Human Services and in accordance with the requirements of Section 1616(e) of the Social Security Act (Keys Amendments), I hereby certify as follows:

1. The State of North Dakota establishes and enforces standards for residential facilities where significant numbers of Supplemental Security Income (SSI) recipients reside;
