RAD LIVE Q&A SESSIONS

HUD only received authority to do Second Component conversions for Fiscal Years 2012 and 2013, which means the demonstration sunsets on September 30, 2013. Owners are advised that both the “triggering event” and the submission of a completed conversion requests must both occur by the sunset date. Importantly, per the RAD Notice, prospective Rent Supp and RAP conversion requests, including all the required tenant consultation information, must be submitted at least 60 days prior to the triggering event. **The latest possible date to submit materials for prospective requests is therefore August 2nd, and owners should be advised that final approval will be subject to the availability of fiscal year 2013 Tenant Protection Funds.** For retroactive conversion requests, complete applications can be submitted up to the sunset date.
