Dear Mr. Logan:

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1616(e) of the Social Security Act, I certify that the Tennessee Health Facilities Commission (HFC), as the designated State Survey Agency for coordinating compliance with the Keys Amendment; the Tennessee Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (TDMHSAS); and the Tennessee Department of Disabilities and Aging (DDA), are in compliance with the statutory and regulatory provisions of the Keys Amendments.

In the 2022 legislative session, the Tennessee General Assembly passed Public Chapter 1119 to create a new independent state agency, HFC. HFC is formed from the former Health Services and Development Agency (HSDA) and Department of Health's Office of Health Care Facilities (OHCF). The Health Facilities Commission is the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid (CMS) designated State Surveying Agency (SSA). The Health Facilities Commission encompasses the Certificate of Need Program, the Health Facilities Commission (formerly the Board for Licensing Health Care Facilities which sunset July 1, 2024), the Nursing Home Civil Monetary Penalty Reinvestment Program, Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA) Program, conducts the surveys and investigations of health facilities to ensure compliance with state and federal regulations, and licenses seventeen (17) different types of health care facilities.

- SB1769/HB1640 Mental Illness As enacted, enacts "Jillian's Law," which makes various changes
 relative to being adjudicated as a mental defective or judicially committed to a mental institution,
 including requiring a person judicially committed to remain committed until the competency of the

- person to stand trial is restored or, if competency is unable to be restored but the person no longer meets the standard, until the court with criminal jurisdiction over the charges approves a mandatory outpatient treatment plan that accounts for the safety of the community. Public Chapter: 784
- SB2079/HB1682 Mental Illness As enacted, makes changes to the law relative to emergency involuntary admission to inpatient treatment and judicial commitment for nonemergency involuntary inpatient treatment. Allows a Qualified Advanced Practice Provider to sign one of the Certificates of Need for the probable cause and judicial commitment hearings as long as the Qualified Advanced Practice Provider is not in a collaborating agreement with the licensed physician who signed the other Certificate of Need. - SB2801/HB2921 Insurance, Health, Accident As enacted, requires TennCare health benefit plans
 to provide coverage and reimbursement for mental health services and treatment to the same extent
 that the plans provide coverage and reimbursement for the treatment of alcoholism and drug

- SB2749/HB2936 Children As enacted, enacts the "Families' Rights and Responsibilities Act."
 Establishes the liberty and fundamental right of a parent to the care, custody, and control of the parent's child, including the right to direct the upbringing, education, health care, and mental health of the child. Public Chapter: 1061
- SB2250/HB2429 DUI Offenses As enacted, states that the court, rather than the sheriff or administrative officer of a local jail, may authorize the use of alternative facilities for the incarceration of an offender convicted of a first time offense of driving under the influence. Public Chapter: 774
- SB2297/HB2308 Drugs, Prescription As enacted, makes changes to the law relative to prescribing buprenorphine products. Would allow nurse practitioners and physician assistants to be able to prescribe buprenorphine within a teaching hospital. Public Chapter: 857
- SB1779/HB1639 Hospitals and Health Care Facilities As enacted, provides that, if an
 incapacitated or deceased patient has no authorized representative, the patient's next of kin will be
 treated as an authorized representative for the patient for the purposes of obtaining the patient's
 hospital records. Public Chapter: 739
- SB1641/HB1883 Hospitals and Health Care Facilities As enacted, establishes that generally an
 attorney or an agent designated to make healthcare decisions under a durable power of attorney for
 health care has a right to in-person visitation with the principal at a hospital where the principal is
 located to evaluate the principal's condition. Public Chapter 766
- SB2363/HB1877 Insurance, Health, Accident As enacted, requires hospitals and physicians to accept electronic insurance cards as valid proof of an insurance policy, plan, or contract. Public Chapter: <u>789</u>
