# FHA Connection Modifications Planned to Comply with New Home Mortgage Disclosure Act Data Collection Fields

Today, the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) is informing mortgagees of planned changes in the FHA Connection (FHAC) system to capture expanded borrower demographic information that mortgagees must begin collecting on January 1, 2018, in accordance with the new Home Mortgage Disclosure Act (HMDA) Final Rule. This information is available to be collected on the Demographic Information Addendum to the Uniform Residential Loan Application (URLA). However, these changes will not be implemented in FHAC by the January 1<sup>st</sup> collection date. In the interim, FHAC has been temporarily modified to:

- Allow mortgagees to submit the demographic information collected if the currently available fields in FHAC match the borrower(s) submission; or
- Permit the fields to be left blank, if the demographic information collected does not match the currently available fields in FHAC.

FHA has not yet established an implementation date for the expanded demographic information changes in FHAC. An announcement regarding the implementation schedule is expected to be made in the coming weeks.

## **Loan Review System Update**

The Federal Housing Administration (FHA) has completed an update to the Loan Review System (LRS) that expands functionality, making it easier for lenders to track specific cases and perform their own analytics using review data. Specifically, the LRS update consists of two new functions:

- "Search" this function has been added to the main navigation header, allowing lenders to search their reviews by FHA case number, regardless of review status. It also allows lenders to filter and export results, which will be useful as additional search criteria are added in the future.
- "LRS Downloads" this function has been added to the Reports section of LRS, allowing lenders to export detailed data on all their LRS reviews and incorporate it into their own reporting processes.

These new LRS functions are operational and available for use by lenders. Additional details and helpful tips will be included in a future update to the LRS Lender User Manual.
