

Build for the Future Funding Navigator Guide

We are pleased to present the second version of Build for the Future Federal Funding Navigator launched by HUD in September 2024. The purpose of the Navigator is to help HUD partners locate funding across many federal agencies for a variety of project types. Major Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) and Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) programs are listed, along with existing HUD programs that can be layered with IRA and BIL programs. You can save extensive research time by using the Funding Navigator, as the Navigator does much of that research for you. A set of search filters helps you pinpoint the funding opportunity you are looking for:

To ensure eligibility, you can use the **Audience** filter to only show the funding opportunities that you or your organization are eligible for.
