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#### **PURPOSE**

In accordance with the requirements of 24 CFR 93.404(a), the grantee is responsible for managing the day-to-day operations of its HTF program and is required to develop and follow comprehensive written program policies and procedures for the administration of its HTF rental program. The regulation at 24 CFR 93.101(d) requires the grantee to ensure that its subgrantees comply with the requirements of 24 CFR part 93 and carry out the applicable grantee responsibilities. **Therefore, this Exhibit is used to monitor HTF-assisted rental projects from development through project completion as defined in 24 CFR 93.2**. This Exhibit is also used to monitor the use of HTF funds for operating cost assistance and operating cost assistance reserves. The reviewer can use this Exhibit to monitor a grantee/subgrantee's:

- rental development project files,
- rental development program policies and procedures,
- a combination of both project files and policies and procedures, or
- a renewal of operating cost assistance or operating cost assistance reserve for an HTF rental housing project.

The questions in this Exhibit may also be used as an interview instrument for program staff.
