Regular members are classified as those individuals who ride to and from work each day and do not include part-time and casual riders or children. Members must not receive transit subsidy and place of employment must be within a reasonable distance of the HUD Headquarters Building. **ALL ITEMS WILL BE VERIFIED.**

Privacy Act Statement

The data is used to identify parking applicants and pool members, issue permits, and manage the parking facilities. This information may be released to other Federal and non-Federal agencies for use in computer matching programs for identifying and verifying eligibility for a parking space for applicants and pool members on multiple pool applications and transit subsidy. This information will not be otherwise disclosed or released outside of HUD, except as permitted or required by law.
