Privacy Act Statement

Federal Property Management Regulations, Section 101-20.104, Parking Facilities, authorizes the collection of all information which will be used by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to determine your eligibility for a parking space. Failure to provide the information, requested on the form may result in denial of a parking permit. The data is used to identify parking applicants and pool members, issue permits, and manage the parking facilities. This information may be released to other Federal and non-Federal agencies for use in computer matching programs for identifying and verifying eligibility for a parking space for applicants and pool members on multiple pool applications and transit subsidy. This information will not be otherwise disclosed or released outside of HUD, except as permitted or required by law.
