Re: Notice of Determination

Dear Ms. Ujaque:

By notice dated February 2, 2024 (Notice), you were told of the proposed debarment action against you by the Department of Housing and Urban Development for a three-year period from the date of final determination. You were informed of your right to submit, within 30 days of your receipt of the Notice, a written argument and a request for a hearing in opposition to the proposed debarment action. The Notice also advised you that if you did not respond within 30 days, a final determination would be issued.

You did not respond to the Notice within the required 30 days and your debarment has become final. During your period of debarment, you are excluded from procurement and nonprocurement transactions, as either a principal or participant, with HUD and throughout the Executive Branch of the Federal Government. Your debarment is effective for three years from the date of this letter.
