



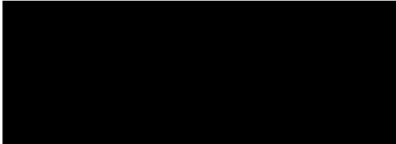

Re: Notice of Final Determination

Dear Ms. Smith:

By notice dated April 22, 2024 (Notice), you were told that the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) proposed your debarment for a five-year period. You were informed of your right to submit, within 30 days of your receipt of the Notice, a written argument, and a request for a hearing in opposition to the proposed debarment action. You also were advised that if you did not respond to the Notice within 30 days, a final determination would be issued.

You did not respond to the Notice within the required 30 days and your debarment has become final. During your debarment, you are excluded from procurement and nonprocurement transactions, as either a principal or participant, with HUD and throughout the Executive Branch of the Federal Government. Your debarment is effective for three years from the date of this notice.
