Dear Ms. Dantzler:

By notice dated April 3, 2025 (Notice), you were informed by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development of your proposed debarment for an indefinite period from September 10, 2024, the date of your suspension. You were informed of your right to submit, within 30 days of your receipt of the Notice, a written request for a hearing. The Notice also advised you that if you did not respond within 30 days, a final determination would be issued.

Because you did not timely respond to the Notice, your debarment is now effective for an indefinite period.

This action is separate and independent of any other enforcement actions that HUD has taken or may take in the future. Nothing herein waives HUD's or any other agency's right to investigate or take any action that they deem appropriate.
