ORDER

On the 28th day of April, 1987, came on to be heard Respondent's, GREGORY TYLER, Appeal of the decision of HUD to suspend his privileges of processing loan applications for HUD/FHA consideration. Having heard argument of counsel and the testimony of witnesses, and having considered all documentary evidence submitted, I conclude that HUD's suspension of Respondent was not based upon adequate credible evidence and should not have issued against Respondent. It is therefore,

ORDERED that the suspension imposed by HUD, communicated to Mr. Tyler in a letter dated March 13, 1987, from Thomas Demery, Assistant Secretary, is hereby revoked and declared void. The revocation of the suspension is effective immediately.

It is further ORDERED that HUD, by and through its local office, located at 2211 Norfolk, Suite 300, Houston, Texas 77098-4096, immediately remove the name of GREGORY TYLER from any memorandum or listing of GREGORY TYLER as a person suspended from doing business with HUD, and that notice be given forthwith to any HUD employee or person having business with HUD who has been notified of Mr. Tyler's suspension of March 13, 1987, that the suspension has been revoked after hearing.*
