ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 26, 1991, the Government issued its complaint against Respondent, suspending her and seeking to debar her for a period of one year from the date of the complaint. By Motion dated May 21, 1991, the Government seeks to dismiss its complaint against Respondent, and to have this debarment action dismissed with prejudice. It appears that although the motion does not indicate the concurrence of Respondent, granting it will not prejudice her interests. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED, that the Government's complaint is *dismissed*, the suspension is *vacated*, and the proceeding in HUDALJ 92-1816-DB is *dismissed with prejudice*.
