DETERMINATION AND ORDER

WHEREAS, on October 29, 1979, the Assistant Secretary for Housing, pursuant to 24 C.F.R. Part 24 (1979), proposed the debarment of Velma Louise Simmons for a period of one year based on her conviction in the United States District Court of the District of Arizona for violation of Title 18, §1012 of the United States Code, and

WHEREAS, Velma Louise Simmons filed a timely Notice of Appeal and thereafter the Assistant Secretary for Housing by letter dated December 17, 1979, amended the proposed period of debarment by reducing it to five months from receipt by Appellant of said letter, and

WHEREAS, the Government has filed a copy of the information filed in the United States Court for the District of Arizona in Criminal Number 79-009 together with a copy of the conviction in that case, and

WHEREAS, the Government has established grounds for the debarment of Velma Louise Simmons, pursuant to §24.6 (a)(1) and (9), 24 C.F.R. §24.6 (1979), and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that a period of debarment be imposed on Velma Louise Simmons.

NOW, therefore, it is, this 18th day of April, 1980

ORDERED

That Velma Louise Simmons shall be, and she hereby is debarred for a period of five months from December 20, 1979, to and including May 20, 1980.
