We secured federal rental assistance for over 100,000 additional households—the largest expansion in 20 years—and developed the first-ever national infrastructure to stop evictions and keep millions in their homes. As we honor this milestone anniversary, I want to express my gratitude to the leaders, officials, and advocates who implement and support this program.
