

HUD GRANTS AND HOUSING VOUCHERS TO ADDRESS UNSHELTERED AND RURAL HOMELESSNESS

On February 2, 2023, HUD announced the first set of 46 communities to receive over \$300 million in Continuum of Care grants through a first-of-its-kind funding initiative to address unsheltered homelessness and homelessness in rural communities. Today’s announcement includes \$171.2 million in grants for 115 new projects in 29 Continuum of Care (CoC) communities. This announcement adds to the first set of grant awards [announced](#) in February, and brings-the total value of grants to \$486 million across 62 CoC communities. In addition, HUD is inviting 139 public housing authorities (PHAs) who are partnering with these Continuum of Care communities to receive 3,362 Stability Vouchers to provide rental assistance to people experiencing or are at-risk of homelessness, including survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, stalking, or human trafficking.

With these resources, communities will implement coordinated approaches that connect homeless outreach, permanent housing, health and supportive services to address homelessness among people in unsheltered settings and/or in rural areas.
