 Step #2: Multiple activities ->HUD will take the percentage of funding from Step #1 and will determine which Subfactor category (3.1a-3.1d) to apply.

HUD will use the category that would provide the applicant with <u>highest points</u>.

Scoring methodology (cont.):

 Acquisition projects->rate under Subfactor depending on nature of the project proposed

 HUD will apply standard rounding rules. Therefore 74.5% would be rounded to 75% while 74.4% would be rounded to 74%.
