March 30-31, 2021 **Indian Housing Plan/Annual Performance Report (IHP/APR)** **ONLINE**

Description: The Association of Alaska Housing Authorities is hosting a two (2) day virtual training on Indian Housing Plan (IHP)/Annual Performance Report (APR). This online workshop will provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of the IHP and APR requirements, the process for developing the local IHP, tracking activities for the APR, step-by-step process for completing the report template and current reference materials related to the IHP and APR. The workshop also incorporates discussion and case studies to facilitate networking and to assist participants in being prepared to complete their IHP and APR.

Description: AAHA will host a three (3) day intensive online training, presenting energy-efficient building techniques for builders, designers, planners, and homeowners. It is an excellent opportunity to learn the latest construction methods related to residential energy efficiency. This course meets the State of Alaska Division of Occupational Licensing educational requirements that qualify general contractors to take the state Residential Endorsement exam (to be eligible, participants must be online/present for the entire training). The building technologies introduced are based on energy conservation through the use of insulation, air/vapor retarders, insulating windows, and controlled ventilation systems, among other methods.

Description: AAHA is hosting an exciting and interactive three (3) day online training with a half day (04/30/2021) being available for participants to schedule a one-on-one session with the trainer. The training will provide attendees with a comprehensive introduction to the Native American Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA). Participants will become familiar with latest regulations, program guidance, and PIH Notices. A thorough review of eligible families and eligible activities including rental housing, homebuyer programs, rehabilitation and housing and crime prevention services will be provided. Other major topics to be addressed include the Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) formula, calculating income eligibility and adjusted gross income, moderate-income family assistances, income verification.

Description: This three (3) day online training is to assist HUD /ONAP program recipients in identifying the changes enacted by the new rule and the applicable conforming regulations of the 2 CFR Part 200 for the following HUD/ONAP regulations, 24 CFR 1000 (IHBG) and 24 CFR 1003 (ICDBG). To support the Tribes/TDHEs during the implementation stage, the training will emphasize the practical changes recipients must make to their administrative and/or management systems (i.e. policies, operating procedures, and other internal control processes) to ensure ongoing compliance with the new Uniform Guidance (2 CFR Part 200)

Topics to be addressed include; Fiduciary Responsibilities; Conflict of Interest; Procurement; Compliance and Monitoring; Admissions Requirements; Policy Requirements; and Decision Making. This course provides the foundation for Board of Commissioner and Tribal Council members to be successful in applying applicable rules and policies to conflict resolution and decision-making. Case studies, group discussions, and hands-on exercises will be applied to reinforce NAHASDA concepts.
