On September 9, 2025, HUD announced the FY 2025 ICDBG NOFO. Tribes and Tribal organizations can apply for a share of approximately \$70 million to support housing, community development, and economic opportunities for low- and moderate-income Native communities. Applications are due by 11:59:59 PM EDT on November 24, 2025, via [Grants.gov](https://www.grants.gov) ([www.grants.gov](https://www.grants.gov)).

ONAP will host a national, virtual one-day training on October 16, 2025, to provide an overview of the FY 2025 ICDBG NOFO and the application process.
