Subject: HUD is Seeking Nominations for the Tribal Intergovernmental Advisory Committee

Dear Tribal Leader:

HUD has published a <u>Federal Register Notice</u>, to solicit nominations for future members of its Tribal Intergovernmental Advisory Committee (TIAC). Selected nominees will serve a two-year term, beginning January 2026.

HUD invites Tribes to nominate Tribal representatives to serve on the TIAC. Nominees must meet the criteria described in the Notice and **nominations must be submitted on or before July 18, 2025**. To submit a nomination, please go to <u>Regulations.gov</u> and press the blue Comments button. You can either <u>upload a document or type the name of the person</u> that you would like to nominate in the comment box and provide any additional documentation.

In determining who to select, HUD will take into consideration several factors, such as geographic location and size of Tribe. To be eligible, the nominee must be a duly elected or appointed Tribal leader or Tribal employee (employees of a Tribally Designated Housing Entity are not eligible).
