

# Notice of Due Date for Submission of FY18 Emergency Safety and Security Applications – Due Monday June 4, 2018

On March 9, 2016, HUD issued PIH Notice 2016-03 (the “Notice”) (effective which set forth the Emergency Safety and Security annual funding notification and application process. The Notice remains in effect until amended, superseded or rescinded. Per paragraph 9 of the Notice, HUD is notifying PHAs that FY18 Emergency Safety and Security applications will be due no later than the **close of business 5:00pm Eastern Daylight Time (EDT) Monday June 4, 2018**

**Note: HUD made a technical change with PIH Notice 2016-03.** The form HUD-50077 is now the HUD-50077-ST-HCV-HP. All PHAs except MTWs submitting Safety and Security applications must submit the form HUD-50077-ST-HCV-HP in lieu of the form HUD-50077. MTW agencies may submit a copy of the MTW certifications of compliance submitted with the most recent MTW Agency Plan. Form HUD-50077-ST-HCV-HP is currently available on HUD CLIPS:

The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2018, (“2018 Appropriations Act”) (Public Law No: 115-141) was enacted on March 23, 2018. The 2018 Appropriations Act did not change the set-aside of Capital Funds for emergencies and natural disasters which remains \$21.5 million. The 2018 Appropriations Act requires that not less than \$5 million of the set-aside for emergency capital needs be used for necessary safety and security measures to address crime and drug-related activity in public housing. HUD will fund \$5 million of Safety and Security capital grants in FY18, the same amount that was funded in FY17.
