On September 9, 2025, HUD announced the FY 2025 ICDBG NOFO. Tribes and Tribal organizations can apply for a share of approximately \$70 million to support housing, community development, and economic opportunities for low- and moderate-income Native communities. Applications are due by **11:59:59 PM EDT on December 10, 2025**, via [Grants.gov \(www.grants.gov\)](https://www.grants.gov).
