

Runaway & Homeless Youth Program

FUNDING ESTIMATES

- Basic Center Program: \$13.4 Million/68 awards/\$200,000 per year, project period up to 3 years
- **Street Outreach Program:** \$6.9 Million/47 awards/\$150,00 per year, project period up to 3 years
- Transitional Living Program: \$20.6 Million/83 awards/\$250,000 per year, project period up to 3 years
- Maternity Group Home: \$6.8 Million/28 awards/\$250,000 per year, project period up to 3 years
- RHY funding is awarded through a competitive process. Applications are solicited through the Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) published each spring.

HOW TO APPLY

RHY Program Eligibility

- Public (state, local and Tribes) and private non-profit entities (faith-based, community-based, and tribal organizations) and coordinated networks of such entities, are eligible to apply for a RHY Program grant. Any organization that is part of a state or local juvenile justice system is not eligible to apply. For-profit organizations are not eligible. Private institutions of higher education must be non-profit entities.
