

Notice of Due Date for Submission of FY20 Capital Fund Emergency Safety and Security Applications – Due Tuesday, November 17, 2020

On September 17, 2020, HUD issued PIH Notice 2020-25 (the “Notice”), which set forth the Emergency Safety and Security annual funding notification and application process. The Notice remains in effect until amended, superseded or rescinded. Per section 9 of the Notice, HUD is notifying PHAs that FY20 Emergency Safety and Security applications will be due no later than the **close of business 5:00pm Eastern Daylight Time (EDT) Tuesday, November 17, 2020.**

Available Funding

The FY2020 Further Consolidated Appropriations Act, (“2020 Appropriations Act”) (Public Law No: 116-94) was enacted on December 20, 2019. The 2020 Appropriations Act maintains the set-aside of Capital Funds for emergencies and natural disasters at \$30 million. The 2020 Appropriations Act requires that not less than \$10 million of the set-aside for emergency capital needs be used for necessary safety and security measures to address crime and drug-related activity in public housing. HUD will fund \$10 million of Safety and Security capital grants in FY20.

PHAs should review the Notice thoroughly to fully understand the requirements for these funds. If a PHA has eligible activities and decides it wishes to apply for available funds, it should refer to Section 11 of the Notice for the application submission requirements. There is no separate application that needs to be submitted, only the submission requirements in Section 11 of the Notice.
