






Fig. 2: 1896 GLO map showing project area location with structures most likely representing the "miner's houses" working for the coal company





Fig. 1: Location of the proposed Coalgate Choctaw Elder Housing Project area; USA Topo Maps map service provided by ESRI. (1:24,000 paper topographic map: Coalgate, Oklahoma Quad 1957, Photo revised 1979)
