May 21-22 **Indian Housing Plans/Annual Performance Reports** Reno, NV

Successful submission of an Indian Housing Plan (IHP) and an Annual Performance Report (APR) is a compliance requirement under the Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) program. The IHP identifies need and describes the recipient's plans for using the IHBG to carry out eligible housing activities. The APR describes progress made toward meeting the IHP goals and demonstrates financial accountability. Participants at this 2-day training will receive step-by-step instruction on how to successfully complete the combined, automated IHP/APR form. The trainer will provide a walk-through of EPIC, the system for submitting the IHP/APR. Participants will also receive guidance on the development, planning, and reporting processes and requirements. All grantees are encouraged to attend this training. **Please note:** Training materials will be provided on USB thumb drives. Participant binders will not be available.
