Content includes a detailed review of the eligibility and underwriting requirements for originating FHA-insured forward mortgages in Presidentially-Declared Major Disaster Areas using FHA's 203(h) Mortgage Insurance for Disaster Victims Program and 203(k) Rehabilitation Mortgage Insurance Program.
