90-Day Conditional Extension of Foreclosure Moratorium for Areas Affected by Hurricane Maria in Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands

Today, the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) published <u>Mortgagee Letter (ML) 2018-03</u>, "*Extension of Disaster Foreclosure Moratoriums for Specified Areas Impacted by Hurricane Maria in Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands*," which extends the current foreclosure moratorium *only* for certain mortgaged properties in areas impacted by Hurricane Maria in the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)-designated Individual Assistance Areas within the Presidentially-Declared Major Disaster Areas (Affected Counties) in Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands. This extension is applicable if the mortgage was no more than 60-days past due as of the date of the PDMDA, and the borrowers have not already been approved for forbearances or other loss mitigation options. The extension may be for a maximum of 90 days if additional requirements specified in the ML have been met.

HUD is exercising its authority to conditionally extend the current foreclosure moratorium due to the extensive damage caused by Hurricane Maria in Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands. This extension applies to both the initiation of foreclosures and foreclosures already in process. <u>ML 2018-03</u> is effective immediately.
