This training is intended for direct endorsement underwriters

and loan processors; however, other mortgage lending professionals may benefit from attending.

Special Instructions:

Advance registration is required; seats are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis. Walk-ins are welcome, but admittance is not guaranteed. Lunch is on your own. On-site parking is also available for a fee.
