Mortgagee Review Board: Administrative Actions Notice Published in Federal Register

Today, the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) published a notice in the *Federal Register* (FR) (<u>Docket No. (FR-6163-N-01)</u> of all completed administrative actions taken by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Mortgagee Review Board during the period from October 1, 2017, through November 14, 2018. The FR Notice provides a description of, and the cause for, the Mortgagee Review Board's administrative actions against HUD-approved mortgagees in 17 fact-based cases and 31 annual recertification violations.
