FHA representatives from the Santa Ana Homeownership Center will conduct a free, two-day, on-site, instructor-led classroom training covering a wide range of topics, including: [Single Family Housing Policy Handbook 4000.1](#); underwriting an FHA appraisal and endorsement protocols; the Loan Review System (LRS); and more.

Who Should Attend: Direct Endorsement underwriters, loan processors and other seasoned mortgage professionals may benefit from this training.
