FHA Seeks Feedback on Draft Payment Supplement Borrower Disclosures

Today, the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) posted draft borrower disclosures that correspond with its draft Mortgagee Letter (ML) Payment Supplement posted on the [Single Family Housing Drafting Table \(Drafting Table\)](#) for public feedback on November 16, 2023.

Interested stakeholders are encouraged to review and provide feedback on both the draft Payment Supplement ML and the newly posted draft borrower disclosures through December 12, 2023. Instructions for viewing and providing feedback on the draft ML and draft borrower disclosure documents are available on the [Drafting Table](#). FHA will carefully consider all feedback received before publishing a final ML and accompanying documents.

As a reminder, this draft ML is not official departmental policy and cannot be used in connection with any FHA-insured mortgage. FHA's existing policies remain in effect until publication of a final ML on HUD's website.
