Virtual: FHA New Applicant Webinar

April 25, 2024 | 2:00 PM – 3:30 PM (Eastern)

This free, virtual webinar, conducted by FHA's Office of Lender Activities and Program Compliance, will focus on the [Lender Electronic Assessment Portal \(LEAP\)](#) as outlined in the [Single Family Housing Policy Handbook 4000.1](#). Content includes a detailed overview of the FHA lender approval application process, eligibility requirements, and required documentation for the various types of mortgagees (lenders). Common application deficiencies will also be addressed and tips for submitting a successful application will be provided. The webinar concludes with a live question and answer (Q&A) session.

Who Should Attend: Non-federally insured or chartered entities, such as mortgage brokers, mortgage bankers, mortgage investors, and/or mortgage servicers interested in becoming FHA-approved lenders or investors.
