On July 9, 2024, in <u>FHA INFO 2024-44</u>, the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) announced the publication of <u>Mortgagee Letter (ML) 2024-13</u>, *Revisions to the 203(k) Rehabilitation Mortgage Insurance Program including updates to the 203(k) Consultant Requirements and Fees.*
