FHA Reposts its Draft Modernization of Engagement with Borrowers in Default Mortgagee Letter

Today, the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) posted an enhanced draft version of the *Modernization of Engagement of Borrowers in Default Mortgagee Letter* (ML) on its <u>Single Family Housing Drafting Table</u>.

This enhanced version includes line numbers in the left margin to easily cross reference to the feedback worksheet. No other changes were made. FHA makes this enhancement to better serve all its stakeholders.

The review period to provide feedback on the draft ML ends on September 13, 2024. Instructions for viewing the draft ML and providing feedback are available on the FHA <u>Single</u> <u>Family Housing Drafting Table</u>. Feedback already submitted is under review and does not need to be resubmitted. FHA will carefully consider all feedback received before publishing a final ML.
