FHA Publishes its Annual Notice of Administrative Actions taken by the Mortgage Review Board in the *Federal Register*

Today, the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) published in the *Federal Register* (FR) (Docket No. FR-6426-N-01), its annual notice of all completed administrative actions taken by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Mortgagee Review Board from October 1, 2019, through September 30, 2020.

The FR Notice provides a description of, and the cause for, the Mortgagee Review Board's administrative actions against HUD-approved mortgagees in 58 fact-based cases and 17 annual recertification violations.
