Review and Feedback Period Extended for Defect Taxonomy for Servicing Loan Reviews

Today, the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) announces an extension to the deadline for review and feedback on the draft update of the [Single Family Housing Policy Handbook 4000.1](#) (Handbook 4000.1), Appendix 8.0 – FHA Defect Taxonomy for Servicing Loan Reviews. The draft update was posted for feedback on the [Single Family Housing Drafting Table](#) (Drafting Table) as announced in [FHA INFO 21-92](#) on October 28, 2021.

Interested stakeholders are encouraged to thoroughly review and provide feedback to the draft Appendix 8.0 - FHA Defect Taxonomy for Servicing Loan Reviews through the new deadline of January 28, 2022.
