It is the finding of this Office that the publication of the attached Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for the <u>Lead Hazard Reduction Grant Program</u>, described by the attached funding notice (FR-6600-N-13A), does not constitute a major federal action having an individual or cumulative significant effect on the human environment, and therefore does not require the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement.

The notice, updated and reissued in this round 2 publication, sets out the guidance to govern the Lead Hazard Reduction Grant Program, which is authorized by Section 1011 of the Residential Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Act of 1992 (Title X of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1992, 42 U.S.C. 4852). Funding is provided by the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022 (Public Law 117-103, enacted March 15, 2022), and the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 (Public Law 116-260, enacted December 27, 2020). The Healthy Homes Supplemental funding is authorized under Section 502 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1970 (12 U.S.C. 1701z-2), and funding is provided by The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022 (Public Law 117-103, enacted March 15, 2022).

This brief Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact provides verification that the attached Environmental Assessment and FONSI for FR-6600-N-13, round 1, remains applicable to this updated and reissued funding notice (FR-6600-N-13A).
