RENTAL HOUSING PROGRAMS

HUD'S PUBLIC HOUSING PROGRAM

WHAT IS PUBLIC HOUSING?

Public housing was established to provide decent and safe rental housing for eligible low-income families, the elderly, and persons with disabilities. Public housing comes in all sizes and types, from scattered single-family houses to high rise apartments for elderly families. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) administers Federal aid to local public housing agencies (PHAs) that manage the housing for low-income residents at rents they can afford. HUD furnishes technical and professional assistance in planning, developing, and managing these developments.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Public housing is limited to low-income families and individuals. A PHA determines your eligibility based on 1) annual gross income; 2) whether you qualify as elderly, a person with a disability, or as a family; and 3) U.S. citizenship or eligible immigration status. If you are eligible, the PHA will check your references to make sure you and your family will be good tenants. PHAs will deny admission to any applicant whose habits and practices may be expected to have a detrimental effect on other tenants or on the project's environment.

PHAs use <u>income limits</u> developed by HUD. HUD sets the **lower income** limits at 80% and **very lowincome** limits at 50% of the median income for the county or metropolitan area in which you choose to live. <u>Income limits</u> vary from area to area so you may be eligible at one PHA but not at another. The PHA serving your community can provide you with the income levels for your area and family size, or you can also find the <u>income limits</u> here on the internet.

HOW DO I APPLY?

If you are interested in applying for public housing, contact your <u>local PHA</u>. If you have trouble contacting the PHA, contact the local <u>HUD Field Office</u>.

WHAT ARE HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHERS?

The housing choice voucher program is the federal government's major program for assisting very lowincome families, the elderly, and the disabled to afford decent, safe, and sanitary housing in the private market. Since housing assistance is provided on behalf of the family or individual, participants can find their own housing, including single-family homes, townhouses, and apartments. The participant is free to choose any housing that meets the requirements of the program and is not limited to units located in subsidized housing projects.

Housing choice vouchers are administered locally by public housing agencies (PHAs). The PHAs receive federal funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to administer the voucher program.

A family that is issued a housing voucher is responsible for finding a suitable housing unit of the family's choice where the owner agrees to rent under the program. This unit may include the family's present residence. <u>Rental units must meet minimum standards of health and safety</u>, as determined by the PHA. A housing subsidy is paid to the landlord directly by the PHA on behalf of the participating family. The family then pays the difference between the actual rent charged by the landlord and the amount subsidized by the program. Under certain circumstances, if authorized by the PHA, a family may use its voucher to purchase a modest home.

AM I ELIGIBLE?

Eligibility for a housing voucher is determined by the PHA based on the total annual gross income and family size and is limited to US citizens and specified categories of non-citizens who have eligible immigration status. In general, the family's income may not exceed 50% of the median income for the county or metropolitan area in which the family chooses to live. By law, a PHA must provide 75 percent of its voucher to applicants whose incomes do not exceed 30 percent of the area median income. Median income levels are published by HUD and vary by location. The PHA serving your community can provide you with the income limits for your area and family size.

During the application process, the PHA will collect information on family income, assets, and family composition. The PHA will verify this information with other local agencies, your employer and bank, and will use the information to determine program eligibility and the amount of the housing assistance payment.

If the PHA determines that your family is eligible, the PHA will put your name on a waiting list, unless it is able to assist you immediately. Once your name is reached on the waiting list, the PHA will contact you and issue to you a housing voucher.

If you are interested in applying for a voucher, contact the <u>local PHA</u>. For further assistance, please contact the <u>HUD Office</u> nearest to you.

OFFICE OF MULTIFAMILY HOUSING

WHAT ARE MULTIFAMILY PROPERTIES?

A HUD Multifamily Assisted property includes properties that receive HUD project-based assistance through its Section 8 rental assistance program; Section 202 Housing for Low-income Elderly; or Section 811 Housing for Persons with Disabilities programs; and formerly assisted Multifamily properties with continuing use restrictions.

AM I ELIGIBLE?

Eligibility is determined by the property management agent based on the total annual gross income and family size and is limited to US citizens and specified categories of non-citizens who have eligible immigration status.

During the application process, the management agent will collect information on family income, assets, and family composition. Management will verify this information with other local agencies, your employer and bank, and will use the information to determine program eligibility and the amount of the housing assistance payment.

If management determines that your family is eligible, they will put your name on a waiting list, unless it is able to assist you immediately. Once your name is reached on the waiting list, management will contact you.

HOW DO I APPLY?

If you are interested in applying at a multifamily property, please contact the management agent for each property. For further assistance, please contact the <u>HUD Office</u> nearest to you.

FILING A HOUSING DISRIMINATION COMPLAINT



If you believe your rights may have been violated, we encourage you to submit a complaint with the Office of Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity (FHEO). Because there are time limits on when a complaint can be filed with HUD after an alleged violation, you should submit a complaint as soon as possible.

When submitting a complaint, please provide as much information as possible, including:

- Your name and address.
- The name and address of the person(s) or organization your complaint is against.
- The address or other identification of the housing or program involved.
- A short description of the event(s) that cause you to believe your rights were violated; and
- The date(s) of the alleged violation.

Privacy Statement: The information submitted to HUD may be used to investigate and process claims of housing and other types of discrimination. It may be disclosed for lawful investigatory purposes, including to the U.S. Department of Justice for its use in the filing of pattern and practice suits of housing discrimination or the prosecution of the person(s) who committed the discrimination where violence is involved; the public, where appropriate; and to State or local fair housing agencies that administer substantially equivalent fair housing laws for complaint processing. Though disclosure of the information is voluntary, failure to provide some or all the requested information may result in the delay or denial of help with your housing discrimination complaint.

RETALIATION IS ILLEGAL

It is illegal to retaliate against any person for making a complaint, testifying, assisting, or participating in any manner in a proceeding under HUD's complaint process at any time, even after the investigation has been completed. The Fair Housing Act also makes it illegal to retaliate against any person because that person reported a discriminatory practice to a housing provider or other authority. If you believe you have experienced retaliation, you can file a complaint.

ASSISTANCE FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

HUD provides a toll-free teletypewriter (TTY) line: 1-800-877-8339. You can also ask for disability-related assistance when you contact FHEO, including reasonable accommodations and auxiliary aids and services.

ASSISTANCE FOR PERSONS WITH LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

You can file a complaint in any language. For persons with limited English proficiency, HUD provides interpreters. HUD also provides a <u>Spanish language version</u> of the online housing complaint form. You can find descriptions of your fair housing rights in several languages other than English <u>here</u>.

TYPES OF COMPLAINTS INVESTIGATED BY FHEO

FHEO investigates complaints, which may be one or both of the following types:

- Discrimination under the Fair Housing Act (including housing that is privately owned and operated)
- Discrimination and other civil rights violations in housing and community development programs, including those funded by HUD

CONSUMER FEES FOR HOUSING COUNSELING

Foreclosure prevention counseling and homeless counseling services are available free of charge through HUD's Housing Counseling Program. Housing Counseling agencies participating in HUD's Housing Counseling Program are not permitted to charge consumers for these specific housing counseling services. Counseling recipients should not pay for these services. However, housing counseling agencies are permitted to charge reasonable and customary fees for other forms of housing counseling and education services, including pre-purchase, reverse mortgage, rental, and non-delinquency post-purchase counseling services, provided certain conditions are met:

- Agencies must provide counseling without charge to persons who demonstrate they cannot afford the fees.
- Agencies must inform clients of the fee structure in advance of providing services.
- Fees must be commensurate with the level of services provided.

If you encounter housing counseling agencies that you believe are not complying with these requirements, you should contact HUD's Office of Housing Counseling.
