

**RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On January 8, 2013, the Secretary filed a motion to dismiss in this case. The Secretary states that “[t]he Secretary is dismissing his action to pursue administrative wage garnishment because HUD’s Financial Operations Center has confirmed that Petitioner is currently unemployed, and was involuntarily separated from his last place of employment.” Secretary’s Motion to Dismiss, ¶2. Upon consideration, and without objection, the Secretary’s Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED. It is

**ORDERED** that this case is DISMISSED without prejudice. It is

**FURTHER ORDERED** that the Secretary is NOT authorized to proceed with administrative wage garnishment against Petitioner at this time. However, the Stay of Referral entered in this case on September 27, 2012 is hereby VACATED, indefinitely, or until further Order of this Court.
