RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On November 6, 2013, the Secretary filed a motion to dismiss this case. *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss*, dated November 6, 2013. The Secretary states that:

The Secretary and Petitioner have agreed that Petitioner's wages will be garnished by HUD to repay her debt; and in order to avoid undue financial hardship to Petitioner, the garnishment amount will be reduced as further agreed by the parties . . . Additionally, the Secretary retains the right to seek additional garnishment of Petitioner's wages, or any other method of collection, should Petitioner's circumstances change in the future, if Petitioner's debt to the Department remains outstanding.

Id. Upon consideration, and for good cause shown, the Secretary's Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED. It is

ORDERED that this case is DISMISSED without prejudice, and the stay of referral of this matter to the U.S. Department of the Treasury, issued on September 25, 2013 is hereby VACATED.
