Subject **Extension of Temporary Approval Provisions for the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) Condominium Project Approval Process**

Purpose This Mortgagee Letter (ML) announces an extension of the temporary condominium project approval guidelines issued in ML 2012-18 to allow time for completion of the condominium rulemaking process.

Extension of Expiration Date The requirements established in ML 2012-18 are extended until August 31, 2016.

Changes No changes have been made to the policy announced in ML 2012-18.

Information Collection Requirements The information collection requirements contained in this document have been approved by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) under the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995 (44 U.S.C. 3501-3520) and assigned an OMB control number of 2502-0610.
