
ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 12, 2014, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) filed a *Complaint* against Elizabeth Jackson (“Respondent”) seeking 44 civil penalties and 44 assessments under the Program Fraud Civil Remedies Act of 1986 and 24 C.F.R. Part 28, for a total award of \$55,698.78. The *Complaint* alleged Respondent filed false and fraudulent claims for Section 8 housing assistance payments.

On December 4, 2014, HUD withdrew the *Complaint* and moved for dismissal of the matter as the parties have reached a settlement. HUD attached a copy of the settlement agreement as support for its *Motion to Dismiss Based on Settlement Agreement*.

For good cause, and without objection, the matter is **DISMISSED**. Further, the pending *Government’s Motion for Default* is **DENIED** as moot.
