**RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On May 23, 2014, the Secretary filed a motion to dismiss this case. *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss*, dated May 23, 2014. The Secretary states that:

[i]n exchange for Petitioner's acknowledgement that she owes the full amount of the debt and dismissal of her Hearing Request in the instant matter, HUD agreed to reduce the current garnishment amount as requested by Petitioner. Accordingly, prior to the date that HUD was required to suspend withholding pursuant to the February 4, 2014 Wage Garnishment Order, HUD issued an amended Administrative Wage Garnishment Order to reflect the revised and agreed upon garnishment amount of \$175.00 per pay period.


Petitioner has agreed to the proposed repayment schedule offered by the Department's Financial Operations Center in the amount of \$175.00 per pay period until her debt is repaid in full. *Id.*, Exhibit 1, Declaration of Brian Dillon, Director, Asset Recovery Division, HUD Financial Operations Center, including Exhibit A, emails between Petitioner and Brian Dillon, dated May 6, 2014.

UPON CONSIDERATION of the Secretary's Motion to Dismiss, and for good cause shown, the Secretary's Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED. It is

**ORDERED** that this case is DISMISSED *without prejudice*, and the stay of referral of this matter to the U.S. Department of the Treasury, issued on April 2, 2014, is hereby VACATED.

Petitioner is hereby notified that the Secretary may seek to reinstitute this administrative wage garnishment proceeding if, in the future, Petitioner fails to comply with Petitioner's repayment agreement with the Department.
