## RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On July 7, 2014, the Secretary filed a motion to dismiss this case. *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss*, dated July 7, 2014. The Secretary states that:

In exchange for Petitioner's acknowledgement that she owes the full amount of the debt and dismissal of her Hearing Request in the instant matter, HUD agreed to reduce the current garnishment amount as requested by Petitioner. Accordingly, HUD will issue to Petitioner's employer a new Wage Garnishment Order to reflect the revised and agreed upon garnishment amount of \$135.00 per pay period."

*Id.* (citation omitted), ¶3.

UPON CONSIDERATION of the Secretary's Motion to Dismiss, and for good cause shown, the Secretary's Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED. It is

**ORDERED** that this case is DISMISSED without prejudice, and the stay of referral of this matter to the U.S. Department of the Treasury, previously issued on June 17, 2014, is hereby VACATED.

Petitioner is notified that the Secretary may reinstitute this administrative wage garnishment proceeding if, in the future, Petitioner fails to comply with Petitioner's repayment agreement with the Department.
