
ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On December 18, 2013, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss* ("*Motion*"), along with supporting documentation, seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt via administrative wage garnishment because garnishment of Petitioner's wages, at this time, would cause Petitioner financial hardship." (See *Motion*, Ex. A, Declaration of Brian Dillon.) Upon due consideration, the *Motion* is **GRANTED**.

The stay of referral shall remain in place until such time as Petitioner's financial circumstances improve. However, HUD shall retain the right to seek collection of the subject debt via alternative means, i.e. administrative offset, and may resume administrative wage garnishment activities in the future should Petitioner's financial circumstances improve.

This matter of HUDOHA #14-VH-0034-AG-015 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**. It is
