
ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On April 18, 2014, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss*, along with supporting documentation, seeking to “dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt via Administrative Wage Garnishment because Petitioner filed a Chapter 13 bankruptcy petition in the United States Bankruptcy Court District of South Carolina on April 14, 2014.” (See *Motion to Dismiss*, Ex. A, Declaration of Brian Dillon.) The Chapter 13 bankruptcy proceeding is currently active. (*Id.*) Upon due consideration, the *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**.

Pending the outcome of the Chapter 13 bankruptcy proceeding, the Secretary shall not seek to collect the claimed debt of Petitioner by means of administrative wage garnishment. The stay of referral shall remain in place until such time as the status of the Chapter 13 bankruptcy proceeding is determined.

This matter of HUDOHA #14-VH-0081-AG-034 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
