## ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On July 2, 2014, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss*, along with supporting documentation, informing the Court that "[I]n exchange for Petitioner's acknowledgment that he owes the full amount of the debt and dismissal of his Hearing Request in the instant matter, HUD agreed to reduce the current garnishment amount as requested by Petitioner."
